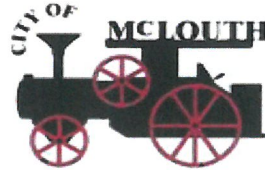

Meeting called to order at 6:52 PM.

Interim Police Chief Williams informed council about the 2016 Ford Explorer all wheel drive SUV. It is in Vinita, OK. Joe Watt purchases police vehicles and sells them back to police departments. Williams called Vinita Police Department and talked to the Chief. He said they have bought 7 vehicles from Mr. Watt.

The vehicle comes with a 12 month 12,000 mile warranty. It has 47,650.3 miles on it. The price is \$16,500. We can have a transport cage included for a total price of \$17,500. The cage itself is \$2,000. He has an extra he is willing to install.

We would need to transfer the lights, sirens and radio. That should be approximately \$500. Discussion of other options ensued.

Interim Chief Williams informed council that this vehicle did hit a deer but does not show any damage. It did have a guard on the front.

Councilman Weissenbach motioned to purchase the 2016 Explorer for \$17,500 with the cage included. Councilman Nowak 2nd, passed 5-0.
