1. Vehicle pursuit report
2. CPR and 1st Aid training for the city employees was conducted on Wednesday, December 13th at 10:00 a.m. Corporal Paul Juedes, who is a full-time paramedic and certified instructor, did an excellent job and we are now all trained or re-trained.
3. I am fairly convinced that the adding of the additional beacons on our school zone sign posts has had a significant effect on slowing down traffic during our school zone times. I have encountered fewer people speeding in the zone or slowing down to the speed limit after entering the zone. Result = increased safety!
4. Following the completion of the user agreement with KDOT, the 800mhz radios were to be installed sometime during the first week of December. This did not happen as we were still acquiring permission from neighboring jurisdictions to include them in our talk groups. We are now scheduled to take one car in for installation tomorrow with the other to follow.
