

**RESOLUTION 2018 – R - 06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MCLOUTH PERTAINING  
TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STOP SIGN ON  
NORTHBOUND MEMORY LANE AT THE  
INTERSECTION WITH WEST GERTRUDE STREET**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2005 and Section 14-201 of the Municipal Code of the City of McLouth, the Governing Body of the City of McLouth, Kansas desires to establish a stop sign on Northbound Memory Lane at the intersection with West Gertrude Street; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic travelling on Northbound Memory Lane is not currently controlled at this intersection with West Gertrude Street; and


**WHEREAS**, having heard public comment and having held deliberations on the matter, the Governing Body deems the establishment of a traffic control device necessary to guide and warn traffic under the provisions of Section 14 of the Municipal Code of the City of McLouth, the Standard Traffic Ordinance as adopted, and the laws of the State of Kansas.

**BE IT NOW RESOLVED** that the Governing Body hereby resolves that:


Northbound Memory Lane at the intersection with West Gertrude Street shall have placed a stop sign which will remain fixed, such that all vehicular traffic travelling Northbound on Memory Lane will be required to stop before entering this intersection.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, and upon posting of the appropriate traffic control signs.


