- ◆ Debbie was approved to work up to 1,000 hours per year. That was 4 years ago. If she goes over the 40 hours both the City and Debbie will need to pay KPERS. She needs more time and she is willing to pay into KPERS if the City is. We are estimating approximately 40 hours over the 1,000. 40 hours = \$466.80. The approximate cost to the City for KPERS is \$45. The cost to Debbie will be approximately \$30. We do not have to start paying KPERS until she reaches the 1,000 hour mark. We pay from there forward; we do not pay for 1,000 hours worked.
