

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 14-204 OF THE MCLOUTH, KANSAS MUNICIPAL CODE: PARKING REGULATIONS – CLARIFYING NO PARKING ON EAST GERTRUDE STREET, NO PARKING OF SEMI-TRUCKS AND TRAILERS IN BUSINESS DISTRICT BETWEEN 11:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M., NO PARKING ZONES ON W. CYNTHIA STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF MCLOUTH, KANSAS:

Section 14-204 of the McLouth Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-204 **PARKING REGULATIONS.** (a) No person shall park any vehicle in the 300 block of *East Gertrude Street* on either side of the roadway; specifically, said prohibited location shall begin at the intersection of Granite Street and *East Gertrude Street*, and extend 175 feet east, along both sides of *East Gertrude Street*, except that a driver may stop temporarily, but not to exceed any time greater than reasonably necessary for or during the actual loading or unloading of passengers or when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs or signals by a police officer.

(b) No truck, trailer or commercial vehicle, with an over-all length in excess of 24 feet, shall remain parked or standing for any period in excess of two consecutive hours on any city street within the zoned business district of the city of McLouth, Kansas.


(c) Parking of semi-trucks and trailers with a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or more shall be prohibited on Union Street within the Business District between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6 ~~p.m.~~ a.m.

(d) Parking on West Lucy Street shall be limited to the North side only from 150 west of Union Street to Summit Street. There shall be no parking on the south side of the street from 150 feet west of Union Street to Summit Street.


(e) *No person shall park a vehicle on the south side of West Cynthia Street west of Union Street to Franklin Street, or on the north side of West Cynthia Street from the alley west of Union Street to Summit Street.*
