

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-01


**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 3-302 OF THE MCLOUTH, KANSAS MUNICIPAL CODE: OCCUPATIONAL TAX, BIENNIAL OCCUPATIONAL TAX ON HOLDERS OF STATE LICENSE FOR RETAIL SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY INCREASED TO \$500**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF MCLOUTH, KANSAS:**


Section 1: Section 3-30 of the McLouth Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-302. OCCUPATIONAL TAX. There is hereby levied a biennial occupation tax of ~~\$250~~ \$500 on any person holding a license issued by the state director of alcoholic beverage control for the retail sale within the city of alcoholic liquors for consumption off the premises. Such tax shall be paid by the retailer to the city clerk before business is begun under an original state license and shall be paid within five days after any renewal of a state license.
