

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16-201 OF THE MCLOUTH MUNICIPAL CODE AND ADOPTING THE 2015 REVISED ZONING REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Article 12, Section 5(b) of the Kansas Constitution empowers cities to determine their local affairs and government ;

WHEREAS, Article 12, Section 5(d) of the Kansas Constitution dictates that the powers and authorities granted under Article 12, Section 5, are to be liberally construed to give to cities the largest measure of self-government; and

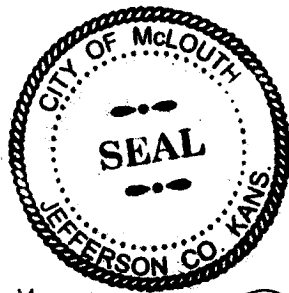
WHEREAS, the City of McLouth, Kansas, has adopted a comprehensive zoning plan to govern building and improvements within the municipal boundaries as set forth in Chapter 16, Article 2 of the McLouth City Code.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MCLOUTH, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 16-201 of the McLouth, Kansas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


16-105 ZONING ORDINANCE INCORPORATED. There is hereby ~~in-corporated~~ incorporated by reference pursuant to K.S.A. 12-741 et seq., as amended, K.S.A. 12-3301, as amended, and K.S.A. 12-3303 through 12-3305, for the purpose of providing zoning regulations within the City of McLouth, Kansas all of the regulations contained in that document hereafter known and referred to as the "~~Zoning Regulations of McLouth, Kansas, October 17, 1995.~~" "2015 Zoning Regulations of McLouth, Kansas. One copy of ~~such Zoning Regulations, City of McLouth, Kansas, October 17, 1995~~ the "2015 Zoning Regulations of McLouth, Kansas," marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of McLouth, Kansas," shall be filed with the city clerk, to be open to inspection and available to the public during regular office hours, except that such official copies may not be removed from city hall.
