
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 8-211 OF THE MCLOUTH, KANSAS MUNICIPAL CODE: EMERGENCY NUISANCE ABATEMENT BY THE CITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF MCLOUTH, KANSAS:


Section 8-211 of the McLouth Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


8-211 EMERGENCY ABATEMENT BY CITY. When, in the opinion of the chief of police, fire chief, public health officer, or other duly designated officer of the city, *a property exists in such a dilapidated condition as to be unfit for human habitation, and which presents a potentially imminent danger of fire, use for criminal activity, or presents a sanitation hazard that endangers the health of those residing in nearby properties,* said officer is hereby authorized and empowered, without any notice of hearing, to order and require such premises to be vacated. The chief of police, fire chief, public officer, or other duly designated officer of the city ~~shall~~ *may* immediately post the premises, warning of the dangerous condition, and ~~shall~~ *may* then abate such nuisance and prepare a statement of costs incurred in the abatement thereof to be certified to the governing body.
