## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 2017-R-02**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN PROPOSED BY THE CITY OF MCLOUTH PLANNING COMMISSION.

Be it Resolved by the Governing Body of the City of McLouth, Kansas:

- Section 1. That the City of McLouth, Kansas has previously directed the City Planning Commission to amend and revise the Zoning Regulations adopted on May 19, 2015.
- Section 2. That the City Planning Commission, as a part of its revision and amendment of the Zoning Regulations, has developed a Comprehensive Land Use Plan for the City of McLouth, Kansas.
- Section 3. That the City Planning Commission has prepared in book form the proposed Comprehensive Land Use Plan for the City of McLouth, Kansas; and,
