

RESOLUTION 2017-R-04

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF McLOUTH CITY COUNCIL RELATING TO UTILITY RATES FOR WATER, SEWER AND GAS SERVICE CUSTOMERS WITHIN THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS OF McLOUTH, KANSAS.

SECTION 15-114 UTILITY RATES based on Monthly Basis:

WHEREAS, the City of McLouth, Kansas operates a water utility which provides water to residential and commercial customers of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of McLouth has lawfully constructed and operates a municipal sewage disposal system, and

WHEREAS, the City of McLouth provides services for the collection and disposal of refuse and other solid waste, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 15, Section 114 of the Code of the City of McLouth and K.S.A. 12-860, the governing body of the City of McLouth shall fix rates, fees or charges sufficient to pay costs of operation, improvement and maintenance of the above referenced services by resolution of the governing body.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McLOUTH, KANSAS:

(a) The City of McLouth declares that the base rates for residential and commercial water use shall be as follows:

\$23.00 for the 1st one thousand gallons (1,000) - water protection fee applies when applicable

\$11.00 per each one thousand (1,000) gallons used after the 1st thousand (1,000)

(b) The City of McLouth declares that the base rates for sewer residential and commercial use shall be as follows:

\$30.00 for the 1st one thousand gallons (1,000)

\$4.00 per each 1,000 gallons used after the 1st thousand (1,000)


(c) The City of McLouth declares that the base rate to be charged for the collection and disposal of solid waste shall be as follows:

\$13.70 per month for each residential and/or commercial unit served


(d) All previous rates for the above referenced city services shall be superseded by this resolution, and said rates shall remain effective until this resolution is repealed and/or replaced by the governing body. In addition, this resolution is not intended to supersede or replace the implementation and collection of any additional fees placed upon customers of these city services that reside outside the city limits of McLouth, Kansas.

This declaration shall be effective 30 days following publication in the official city newspaper.
