

ORDINANCE NO: 2018-03

THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

An ordinance regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of McLouth, Kansas, incorporating by reference the *Standard Traffic Ordinance* for Kansas Cities, edition of 2018, providing certain penalties and repealing ordinance number: 2016-06

Amending Chapter XIV, Article 1, Section 14-101, 14-102

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of McLouth:

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of McLouth, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the *Standard Traffic Ordinance* for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2018, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. One copy of said *Standard Traffic Ordinance* shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 2018-03," and to which shall be attached a copy of ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such *Standard Traffic Ordinance* similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


Section 2. TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES


(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.

(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.
