CHAPTER XXIX. MISCELLANEOUS

ARTICLE 1. General Provisions

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 29-101. VALIDITY. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of these Regulations shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of these Regulations as a whole or any part or provisions thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional. All regulations or parts of regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- 29-102. ACCRUED RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES SAVED. The repeal of the existing Zoning Regulations provided in section 29-104 herein shall not affect any rights accrued, fines, penalties, forfeitures, or liabilities incurred thereunder, or actions involving any of the provisions of said Regulations or parts thereof. Said Regulations below repealed are hereby continued in force and effect, after the passage, approval and publication of these Regulations, for the purpose of such previously accrued rights, or previously incurred fines, penalties, forfeitures, or liabilities, or previous actions thereof.
- 29-103. SEVERABILITY. Each chapter, article, section, and subdivision or subsection of these Regulations is hereby declared to be independent of every other chapter, article, section, or subdivision or subsection, so far as inducement for the passage of these Regulations is concerned.
- 29-104. EFFECTIVE DATE. These Regulations, being designated as the "Zoning Regulations of the City of McLouth, Kansas," shall be in full force and effect from the date after its passage and publication in accordance with K.S.A. 12-3301 through 12-3305.
- 29-105. REPEALING CLAUSE. These Regulations repeal the existing Zoning Regulations of the City of McLouth, Kansas, in its entirety.
