

CHAPTER VI. ELECTIONS

Article 1. City Elections

ARTICLE 1. CITY ELECTIONS

- 6-101. CONDUCT OF ELECTION. The election of city officials shall be conducted in all respects as provided by the laws of Kansas governing the holding of city elections. (K.S.A. 25-2101 et seq.; Code 2012)
- 6-102. HOURS OF VOTING. At all city elections the polls shall be open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m., unless different hours are set and publicly announced by the county election officer. (K.S.A. 25-2111, 26-206; Code 2012)
- 6-103. COMMENCEMENT OF TERMS OF OFFICE; OATH OF OFFICE. (a) The term of office for newly elected city officials shall commence with and include the first regular meeting of the governing body following certification of the election by the county election officer.
(b) Every person elected or appointed to city office, before entering upon the duties of such office, shall take and subscribe an oath or affirmation as specified in K.S.A. 54-106, and amendments thereto, and every such oath or affirmation shall be filed with the city clerk.

- 6-104. ELECTION; TERMS. On the first Tuesday in April 2011, there shall be elected a Mayor (position 1) and two council members (positions 3 and 5) to serve two year terms expiring in 2013. Succeeding elections for positions 1, 3, and 5 shall be held the first Tuesday in April 2013, and every four years thereafter. All such offices beginning in 2013 shall be four year terms. On the first Tuesday in April 2012, there shall be elected three council members (positions 2, 4, and 6) to serve three year terms to expire in 2015. Succeeding elections for positions 2, 4, and 6 shall be held the first Tuesday in April 2015, and every four years thereafter. (C.O. No. 2010-30; Code 2012)
